



To Everyone in the Ransom District Library Community,

While we have never been more excited to be open and serving our community in a beautiful new building, due to the spike in local and regional COVID-19 cases, Ransom District Library will be closed for in-house services for three weeks starting Wednesday, November 18. Nothing is as important as the health of our patrons and staff. The views of the Kalamazoo River from the new Reading Room and the Charles and Betsy Hill Performance Room will wait, as will the spacious new children's area and the media lab. They will wait, and we will protect the most vital resource of all.

In the meantime, Ransom District Library will offer walk-up service through our service window on the east side of the building and curbside delivery of library materials may be requested by calling the Library. Brief appointments for essential access to public computers may also be requested.

During the three weeks that the Library will be mostly closed to the public, Library hours will be reduced by two hours Monday through Thursday. The temporary new schedule will be as follows, starting Wednesday, November 18:

Monday—Thursday 10:00am – 7:00pm, Friday & Saturday 10:00am – 5:00pm, Sunday 1pm – 5pm

*From 5:00—7:00pm walkup services only, no curbside during those hours.
