- Over 250 people attended the Summer Celebration. The Friends of the Library funded the event and also handed out free ice cream.
- The Library is researching an alternative to agverso.com for its catalog search engine.

Assistant's Report

- Summer Reading Program: 599 children registered; 68% completed the required reading.
- There will be a preschool Yoga program monthly during the winter.
- The Friends of the Library donated \$500 to the Children's Room for new toys and other necessities.
